A number of challenges in the short term

- Effective household competition some way off
- Acquisition generally involves investment in networks and production facilities due to prevailing integrated model
- European deal prices are currently very high
- Political requirements of privatisation process

The number of good opportunities in the short term is limited, but......

The European landscape is changing fast

- Signs that liberalisation process is gaining momentum
- Major players repositioning themselves for the future
- Consolidation through process of privatisation
- Early signs of an increase in unbundling

Importance of getting the right opportunity

- Pace and extent of deregulation is key

- May require acquisition first then restructure afterwards
